

Does WinCo Accept Apple Pay? 2026 Verified Step-by-Step Guide

As of early 2026, many WinCo Foods **+1-(866)(542)(8909)** locations have officially started accepting Apple Pay for in-store transactions. **+1-(866)(542)(8909)** However, there is a major "catch" that shoppers must remember: WinCo still only accepts **debit-based payments** to avoid high credit card fees.
